## NOTICE OF GENERAL ELECTION

To all electors of Pimicikamak Okimawin, take notice that in accordance with Section 30 of THE PIMICIKAMAK ELECTION LAW, a general election for the OFFICES OF ONE CHIEF and EIGHT COUNCILLORS, for Pimicikamak Okimawin will be held on:

**THURSDAY, AUGUST 2, 2018**

**POLLS WILL OPEN AT 11:00 AM AND WILL CLOSE AT 7:00 PM. VOTING WILL BE AT THE FOLLOWING POLLING PLACES:**

1. BAND HALL IN CROSS LAKE
2. KE-NA-NOW CENTER IN WABOWDEN
3. COMMUNITY HALL IN THICKET PORTAGE
4. COMMUNITY HALL IN PIKWITONEI
5. MYSTERY LAKE IN THOMPSON

**THE NOMINATIONS WILL BE HELD AT THE BAND HALL IN CROSS LAKE ON:**

**FRIDAY, JULY 6, 2018 FROM 1:00 PM TO 5:00 PM**

QUALIFIED PERSONS MUST BE NOMINATED AND SECONDED IN WRITING AND MUST CONSENT IN WRITING IN APPROVED FORM UNDER THE PIMICIKAMAK ELECTION LAW.

ALL NOMINATION FORMS ARE AVAILABLE FROM THE CHIEF ELECTORAL OFFICER AT 1:00 PM ON JULY 6, 2018.

AN ELECTOR WHO NOMINATES OR SECONDS ANY PERSON MAY NOT NOMINATE OR SECOND ANY OTHER PERSON FOR THE SAME ELECTION IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 42 OF THE PIMICIKAMAK ELECTION LAW.

**IN ACCORDANCE TO THE PIMICIKAMAK CITIZENSHIP LAW, AN ELECTOR MUST BE:**

1. A CITIZEN IN ACCORDANCE TO THE PIMICIKAMAK CITIZENSHIP LAW
2. 18 YEARS OF AGE AS OF THE ELECTION DAY AND MUST PROVIDE IDS

**IN ACCORDANCE TO THE PIMICIKAMAK ELECTION LAW, A NOMINATED CANDIDATE MUST BE:**

1. A QUALIFIED PERSON IN ACCORDANCE TO THE PIMICIKAMAK ELECTION LAW
2. ORDINARILY RESIDENT IN THE TRADITIONAL TERRITORY OF THE NATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PIMICIKAMAK ELECTION LAW
3. 18 YEARS OF AGE

UNDER SECTION 52 AND SECTION 53 OF THE PIMICIKAMAK ELECTION LAW, TO BE VALID, NOMINATIONS MUST BE SUPPORTED BY STATEMENTS IN APPROVED FORM DELIVERED TO THE CHIEF ELECTORAL OFFICER BY 5:00 PM SHARP ON:

**MONDAY, JULY 11, 2018**

AT THE GROUND FLOOR RECEPTION OF THE WALTER MONIAS MEMORIAL ADMINISTRATION BUILDING.

IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 26 OF THE PIMICIKAMAK ELECTION LAW, THE PERSONS ELECTED SHALL BE EX-OFFICIO, THE CHIEF AND THE COUNCILLORS OF THE CROSS LAKE BAND OF INDIANS.

**IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 125 OF THE ELECTION LAW, NO ELECTION WILL BE HELD UNDER THE INDIAN ACT.**
