CROSS LAKE PANDEMIC PLANNING NOTICE TO THE COMMUNITY MAY 18, 2020 CANADA CHILD BENEFIT (CCB)

The Canada Child Benefit (CCB) is administered by the Canada Revenue Agency.

Individuals who received CCB in April, will receive \$300 per child more in their May installment. This is a one-time increase.

You will receive the payment increase automatically the same way you receive your regular CCB payment (direct deposit or cheque).

The following Public Health Orders are still in place in the Province of Manitoba.

- Order prohibiting Travel to Northern Manitoba and remote communities
- Order to maintain the gathering size of no more than 10 people at any indoor or outdoor premises.

Due to the Cross Lake Lockdown and the guidelines, Chief and Council, Mayor and Council and Cross Lake Pandemic Planning Committee have collectively agreed to allow CCB Shopping Days to **Thompson** effective:

- May 20, 21, 22, 23, 2020. This will give people that have been called back to work an opportunity to go shop as well.
- You will only be allowed **once** to go shop in Thompson on any of the given days.
- If any COVID -19 cases become confirmed North of 53° the Shopping Trip will be cancelled immediately.

You will have to fill an Authorization Form to leave the community. You will abide by the contents of the Authorization Form specifically:

I certify that the information is true to the best of my knowledge. I agree to cooperate for the health and safety for myself and others around me. A change in this application without the approval of the Pandemic Team may nullify any future privileges to travel. I understand that this PASS is not transferable to any other person.

I further declare that I will not bring contraband and/or alcohol into the community and will allow my vehicle to be searched upon return. Should I refuse the search, I understand that I may not be permitted entry.

You are signing this document knowingly and willingly, if you are caught with contraband or alcohol your name will be put on a Confiscation List. If your name is on this list, further requests will be denied to leave the community. Respect the Safety Officers that are doing their job as directed by Leadership and following Public Health Orders.
