VACCINATION CLINIC FOR YOUTH 12-17 YEARS OF AGE

& ADULTS 18 YEARS AND OLDER

CROSS LAKE ARENA - Friday, July 9, 2021:

1:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. (or earlier if we run out of vaccines)

The CROSS LAKE Chief David Monias and Council were successful in ensuring the majority of their membership, including our off reserve membership, have the opportunity to be vaccinated with the COVID-19 Vaccine. In partnership with the Cross Lake Nursing Station & Cross Lake Pandemic Planning Committee, Cross Lake will host a COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic on **Friday, July 9, 2021 from 1:00-6:00 pm.**

The Consent Forms will be available at the Cross Lake Arena for anyone getting their 1st dose of Vaccine.

The Pfizer vaccine will be available for the Youth aged 12 – 17 years. The Moderna vaccine will be available for people getting their 1st vaccine. If you have received your 1st dose of Moderna from *June 9, 2021(or prior), you can receive your Second dose.* Our highest group of COVID Positive cases are Children 0-9 years of age, the next highest group is 10-19 years of age

We have a limited amount of Vaccines remaining. We vaccinated 39 people with Moderna & 48 Youth with Pfizer Vaccines today (July 8). For Friday, we only have 13 Moderna & 102 Pfizer Vaccines available. Get there early to guarantee your vaccine. The Clinics will now be every 3 weeks. The next one will tentatively be July 29 & 30, 2021.

Please ensure you have the following:

- Manitoba Health Card (if you do not have one, we will assist you)
- Transportation will be available
- Treaty Status Card
- We will have Greeters that will direct you where to go upon arrival
- Please wear a short sleeve shirt
- Once your vaccine is complete, you will be monitored for 15 minutes and then go home.
