CROSS LAKE VACCINATION - 2nd DOSE - MASS IMMUNIZATION

Through many negotiations by Chiefs and particularly our Chief of the Nation, we will have a 2nd Mass Immunization Clinic in our Community of Cross Lake. The 2nd batch of vaccines were delayed. The Chief and Council, Mayor and Council and Cross Lake Pandemic Planning Committee in collaboration with the Nursing Station have set the tentative dates of:

April 26, 27, & 28, 2021 (Monday – Wednesday) for your 2nd Moderna Vaccine.

- Once your 2nd dose is complete, you will be given a card stating you have finished your two Moderna Vaccinations
- Please wear a short sleeve shirt
- You will transition from immunization space to monitor area for 15 minutes.
- After you have finished your monitor time of 15 minutes, you will be allowed to leave and go home
