CROSS LAKE VACCINATION ROLL OUT PLAN

MASS IMMUNIZATION

Through much negotiations by Chief's and particularly our Chief of the Nation, we will have a Mass Immunization Clinic in our Community of Cross Lake.

The Chief and Council, Mayor and Council and Cross Lake Pandemic Planning Committee in collaboration with the Nursing Station have been advised the following:

- The Cross Lake Vaccination Planning Committee has identified 6 districts similar to the Shopping Districts.
- People will pre-register within their own District with their District Representatives. You are encouraged to pre-register as much as possible.
- Effective Monday, the District Representatives will call you to complete the Consent Forms over the Phone.
- The Nursing Station Public Health will call you to complete the Enhanced Consent Form if you have been identified in the Co-Morbidities' List (If you have heart conditions, pregnant, kidney disease etc.)
- We will be vaccinating according to Districts identified. 1 through 6.
- The Moderna Vaccine will arrive in Cross Lake the **WEEK OF** March 22, 2021
- This will be available to anyone over 18 years of age that wants to get vaccinated
- The Mass Vaccination Clinic will take place at the Cross Lake Arena
- Please wear a short sleeve shirt
- You will get your Moderna Vaccine
- You will transition from immunization space to monitor area
- You will stay in monitor area for 15 minutes and will be monitored during this time
- After you have finished your monitor time of 15 minutes, you will be allowed to leave and go home
