The CROSS LAKE Chief David Monias and Council were successful in ensuring the majority of their membership, including our off reserve membership, have the opportunity to be vaccinated with the COVID-19 Vaccine. **Health Canada has now approved for Youth, ages 12 to 17 years to get vaccinated with the Pfizer Vaccine.** In partnership with the Cross Lake Nursing Station & Cross Lake Pandemic Planning Committee, Cross Lake will host the First Dose Vaccination Clinic for our Youth.

CLEA Staff and D.R. Hamilton Staff will be distributing Consent forms to their students that are the appropriate age for the Pfizer vaccine. Our highest group of COVID Positive cases are Children 0-9 years of age, the next highest group is 10-19 years of age. The Children 0-11 years cannot get a vaccine yet.

Please ensure you have the following:

- Manitoba Health Card (if you do not have one, we will assist you)
- Transportation will be available
- Treaty Status Card
- We will have Greeters that will direct you where to go upon arrival
- Please wear a short sleeve shirt
- Once your 1st dose is complete, You will be monitored for 15 minutes
- After you have finished your monitor time of 15 minutes, you will be allowed to leave and go home
