The CROSS LAKE Chief David Monias and Council were successful in ensuring the majority of their membership, including our off reserve membership, have the opportunity to be vaccinated with the COVID-19 Vaccine. In partnership with the Cross Lake Nursing Station & Cross Lake Pandemic Planning Committee, Cross Lake will host a COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic on Tuesday, June 29 and Wednesday, June 30, 2021.

The Consent Forms will be available at the Cross Lake Arena for anyone getting their 1st dose of Vaccine.

The Pfizer vaccine will be available for the Youth aged 12 – 17 years. 1st and 2nd doses. The Moderna vaccine will be available for people getting their 1st vaccine. If you have received your 1st dose of Moderna prior to *May 29, 2021*, you can receive your Second dose. Our highest group of COVID Positive cases are Children 0-9 years of age, the next highest group is 10-19 years of age. The Children 0-11 years cannot get a vaccine yet.

Please ensure you have the following:

- Manitoba Health Card (if you do not have one, we will assist you)
- Transportation will be available
- Treaty Status Card
- We will have Greeters that will direct you where to go upon arrival
- Please wear a short sleeve shirt
- Once your vaccine is complete, You will be monitored for 15 minutes
- After you have finished your monitor time of 15 minutes, you will be allowed to leave and go home
