CROSS LAKE COVID 19 COMMUNITY NOTICE

JANUARY 9, 2021

EFFECTIVE AT 10:00 P.M. AS OF TODAY'S DATE, SATURDAY, JANUARY 9, 2021 ALL ROADS IN THE COMMUNITY OF CROSS LAKE WILL BE SHUT DOWN FOR 48 HOURS TO MINIMIZE TRAFFIC IN THE COMMUNITY. NO TRAFFIC WILL BE ALLOWED AFTER 10:00 P.M. TONITE. IF YOU ARE STOPPED AT A COMMUNITY CHECKSTOP YOU WILL BE ASKED TO RETURN TO YOUR HOME IMMEDIATELY. ONLY IDENTIFIED DISTRICT SHOPPING WILL BE ALLOWED THE NEXT TWO DAYS. ALL 3 GAS BARS, ALL OFFICES & POST OFFICE WILL BE CLOSED.

THIS GOES FOR SNOWMOBILES AS WELL. IF YOU ARE CAUGHT DRIVING AROUND WITH A SNOWMOBILE YOUR SNOWMOBILE WILL BE CONFISCATED AND WILL BE IMPOUNDED FOR A MINIMUM OF TWO WEEKS. MAIN SKI-DOO TRAILS WILL BE MONITORED AND PATROLLED. PARENTS DO NOT ALLOW YOUR CHILDREN TO DRIVE YOUR SKI-DOO AROUND, IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO ENSURE YOUR PROPERTY IS SAFE.

FAILURE TO SELF ISOLATE IN ACCORDANCE WITH PUBLIC HEALTH ORDER IS A VIOLATION OF THE ORDER AND IS ENFORCEABLE UNDER THE PUBLIC HEALTH ACT. INDIVIDUALS CAN BE SUBJECT TO FINES FOR NON COMPLIANCE.

WE HAVE TOO MANY ISOLATORS THAT ARE NOT FOLLOWING THE ISOLATION ORDERS. THESE PEOPLE ARE OUT AND ABOUT AND COULD POTENTIALLY SPREAD THE COVID 19 VIRUS.
