GUIDELINES FOR NORWAY HOUSE VISITORS

JUNE 15, 2021

The Province of Manitoba is still under Critical Red Level and we still have to be diligent on the Public Health Guidelines by wearing a mask in public places, social distancing and washing hands frequently.

Cross Lake has reached the target of 75% of our eligible population to be vaccinated with two (2) doses of the Moderna Vaccine. Thank you to all the people that took the opportunity to get vaccinated.

The following will be implemented as follows:

Fully vaccinated people can come visit their vaccinated family only; they must contact **Mike Omand, Access to Community Approver** at Cross Lake Band Office: Monday – Friday 9:30 am – 4:00 pm at **(204)676-2218**. They must also inform as to the purpose for requesting entry to Cross Lake.

- Proof of Covid Vacc Cert Card, Shared Health Print out or a provincial Digital QR Code. (*you can download this onto your phone*)
- Visitors will inform the Check Stop Personnel whom they are visiting and for duration of visit.
- All adults, youth ages 12 – 17 will have to have proof of Covid Vacc Cert Card, Shared Health Print out or a Provincial Digital QR Code.
- All children 11 years old and under must be accompanied by their parent (s) and or guardian (s) who have been vaccinated.
- No shopping or attending any Gatherings by anyone from Norway House at this time. Until the Province reviews the present Public Health Orders.
- If you are reported that you are disrespecting and participating in any illegal activities, you will be escorted out of Cross Lake.
- Visitors will be searched at the Check Stop for alcohol and drugs. If you are caught trying to bring alcohol or drugs into the community of Cross Lake, the R.C.M.P. will be notified, you will be escorted out, the NWH Chief and Council will be notified and you will be banned from entering the Community of Cross Lake.
- Visitors will be allowed to fuel up at the Gas Stations prior to leaving Cross Lake.
- Please respect the Provincial Health Orders currently in place.
