CROSS LAKE VACCINATION ROLLOUT COVID -19 MODERNA VACCINES

BACKGROUND:

The Moderna Vaccine is a vaccine that aims to protect against COVID – 19. The vaccine is approved for people who are 18 years of age and older. The vaccine is given by an injection into the muscle of the arm. For the vaccine to work best, you need two (2) doses: a single dose and then a second dose one month apart.

The Cross Lake Pandemic Planning Committee including our local Nursing Station had developed a COVID-19 VACCINATION PLAN for Residents **18 YEARS AND OLDER** of the Cross Lake Band of Indians and Cross Lake Community Council.

Due to the high number of Cross Lake Residents that did not get vaccinated (44% of the population 18 years and up, approximately 1800 people), We are encouraging you to come get a vaccination. We are encouraging the young people to come and get vaccinated. Be proactive and stay healthy. The CLPPC along with the CLNS have scheduled a two day Vaccination Clinic. *Last Chance, any leftover vaccines will be shipped out of Cross Lake on Friday!*

It's Walk-in, no appointment or pre-registration necessary. Just come get your vaccine.
