On April 29, 2020, the Manitoba Government announced the plan to re-open Manitoba and to begin lifting restrictions. **Some Public Health Orders Restriction's will remain:**

- **Travel Restrictions North of 53**
- **Limit of Gathering of 10**

Chief and Council, Mayor and Council and the Cross Lake Pandemic Planning Committee have collectively agreed to allow relatives North of 53 to come and visit their Mother's for Mother's Day Weekend. Unfortunately, at this time we cannot allow visitors South of the 53 Parallel.

You will have to provide a copy of an Authorization Form at the Check stop. The responsibility will be on your family members to ensure that they get a signed copy for you, they can either fax to you or email you to print. The onus will be on you to provide a copy of the original Authorization Form at the Check Stop upon leaving. Mike Omand and/or Henry McKay can sign off Authorization Forms for this purpose.

You will be subject to the following:

- Fill out Questionnaire and sign declaration.
- Subject to search of vehicle, if you do not abide, you will not be allowed in.
- You are subject to 14 days self monitor while here and upon returning to your place of residence and you can utilize the **on-line self assessment tool at www.manitoba.ca/covid19 to determine if you should call Health Links 1-888-315-9257**, if you are feeling symptoms of the following:
