NOTICE TO MEMBERS/RESIDENTS OF CROSS LAKE

UPDATE FROM CHIEF AND COUNCIL/MAYOR AND COUNCIL

Tansi Nitotemak, akwa niwakomakanak akwa kakinaw inninewak!

The Chief and Council were not notified as to the additional positive cases as of this morning. Follow up was done and confirmation is as follows:

Six (6) Individuals of Cross Lake were identified as testing positive for COVID-19. All six individuals have not been in the North but contact tracing and exposure time line is being done by the Province of Manitoba.

All six (6) positive cases are out of the community and self isolating in Winnipeg and they are doing well. This could happen to anyone of us and we need to be kind and not point judgement to anybody. Keep them in your prayers, they too are going through the unknown.

We want to reassure you that the Chief and Council, Mayor and Council and the Cross Lake Pandemic Planning Committee is on top of the situation and is being well managed.

For the safety of the Community the following precautionary measures will be in place until further notice and will be reviewed in 14 days while testing and contact tracing processes are being completed for safety precautions to the Community.

- The Check Stop will continue as is
- The Community Curfew will be implemented from 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
- All Schools, Daycare will be closed for special cleaning and will be closed for the remaining of this week.
- Essential Services only and will need a signed Authorization Form
- Medical Patients only and will need a signed Authorization Form
- Mandatory to wear masks at all places
- Social Distancing of 6 feet recommended
- Consistently washing and sanitizing your hands.

Please people, adhere to these precautionary measures.
