RED CRITICAL LEVEL CROSS LAKE SUNDAY, JANUARY 10, 2021

THE PROVINCE OF MANITOBA HAS EXTENDED THE PUBLIC HEALTH ORDER RED CRITICAL LEVEL TODAY FOR ANOTHER 14 DAYS TILL JANUARY 22, 2021.

THE PROVINCIAL STATE OF EMERGENCY WAS EXTENDED ON JANUARY 3RD FOR ANOTHER 30 DAYS.

THE PROVINCE OF MANITOBA HAD **151 NEW POSITIVE CASES** TODAY JANUARY 10 2021.
44 NEW CASES IN THE NORTHERN HEALTH REGION.

As of today's date there is 0 positive case today (1 previous contact sent out from before turned positive). 30 contacts were tested today. Total tested done to date is 200 contacts. Other contacts are pending to be tested. More potential contacts pending on results from Cadham tests. (These are the one's sent to Cadham Lab).

SUMMARY: JANUARY 10, 2020

- There are **44** confirmed active cases in Cross Lake
- 0 positive cases today (1 positive case from previous Cadham test)
- 30 contacts tested today (25 Cadham, 5 Abbot)
- Non Recovered
- 1 in ICU
- 18 households with active Covid 19 cases
- Average age of positive cases is 31 years old
- 36 confirmed positive cases are in AIA in Winnipeg. The remaining are at 24/7 waiting to be transported to an AIA in Winnipeg.

We have a priority list and the priority for the 200 COVID-19 Vaccines will be Elders 70 years old and over, our Elders are the most vulnerable to get sick. Kasayak Center Clients and Staff and

Home and Community Care Staff are to follow. We received 20 vials, 10 doses in each vial. We have to ensure that we always have 10 Elders ready to take the vaccine, we cannot afford to waste any vaccines.

If you are an Elder 70 years and over and would like to take the Covid-19 Vaccine you can call **204-676-3426. Thank you to all the Elders that have taken the vaccine so far and trust**

A COVID -19 VACCINE Notice has been relayed through the Radio Station and Cross Lake Band of Indians Covid -19 Updates on Facebook. These are frequently asked questions and answered by medical people. You can also phone the COVID-19 Hotline at **204-590-6739** from 8:30 a.m. to 8:30 p.m. if you have questions. You can also ask your local Nurses about the Vaccine.

It is not mandatory to take the COVID-19 vaccine but is strongly recommended that you take it to protect your home, your family and your community.

The **COMMUNITY LOCKDOWN** is still in effect till Tuesday, January 12, 2021 at 7:00 a.m. The ski-doo patrol will still be monitoring the ski-doo trials. You will not be allowed through the checkpoints. **IF YOU DON'T MOVE, THE COVID-19 VIRUS WILL NOT MOVE. PLEASE STAY AT HOME IN YOUR OWN BUBBLE.**
