## **RED CRITICAL LEVEL CROSS LAKE MONDAY, JANUARY 11, 2021**

**THE PROVINCE OF MANITOBA HAS EXTENDED THE PUBLIC HEALTH ORDER RED CRITICAL LEVEL TODAY FOR ANOTHER 14 DAYS TILL JANUARY 22, 2021.**

**THE PROVINCIAL STATE OF EMERGENCY WAS EXTENDED ON JANUARY 3<sup>RD</sup> FOR ANOTHER 30 DAYS.**

THE PROVINCE OF MANITOBA HAD **133 NEW POSITIVE CASES** TODAY JANUARY 11, 2021. **34 NEW CASES** IN THE NORTHERN HEALTH REGION.

### **SUMMARY: JANUARY 11, 2021**

- There are **44** confirmed active cases in Cross Lake
- 0 positive cases today
- 20 tests were done today (16 Cadham, 2 Abbot, 2 Gene)  
The Cadham Tests that were sent out to the Lab - will have results on all tomorrow.
- None Recovered
- 1 in ICU
- 18 households with active Covid-19 cases
- Average age of positive cases is 31 years old
- 36 confirmed positive cases are in AIA in Winnipeg. The remaining were scheduled to leave today. All confirmed cases will now be out of the community.

### **ISOLATION GUIDELINES:**

All positive cases are isolating in AIA in Winnipeg, mandatory to go out.

All contacts of positive cases are to isolate for 14 days.

All negative cases are to isolate for 14 days.

## **COVID 19 VACCINATION CLINICS**

If you are an Elder 69 years and over and would like to take the Covid-19 Vaccine you can call **204-676-3426**. Thank you to all the Elders that have taken the vaccine so far. We had **20** vaccinations scheduled for today.

A COVID -19 VACCINE Notice has been relayed through the Radio Station and Cross Lake Band of Indians Covid -19 Updates on Facebook. These are frequently asked questions and answered by medical people. You can also phone the COVID-19 Hotline at **204-590-6739** from 8:30 a.m. to 8:30 p.m. if you have questions. You can also ask your local Nurses about the Vaccine.

**It is not mandatory to take the COVID-19 vaccine but is strongly recommended that you take it to protect your home, your family and your community.**
