RED CRITICAL LEVEL CROSS LAKE TUESDAY, JANUARY 12, 2021

THE PROVINCE OF MANITOBA HAS EXTENDED THE PUBLIC HEALTH ORDER RED CRITICAL LEVEL TODAY FOR ANOTHER 14 DAYS TILL JANUARY 22, 2021.

THE PROVINCIAL STATE OF EMERGENCY WAS EXTENDED ON JANUARY 3RD FOR ANOTHER 30 DAYS.

THE PROVINCE OF MANITOBA HAS **90 NEW POSITIVE CASES** TODAY JANUARY 12, 2021. **09 NEW CASES** IN THE NORTHERN HEALTH REGION.

SUMMARY: JANUARY 12, 2021

- There are **44** confirmed active cases in Cross Lake (two were taken off and moved to Thompson) which initially showed up as 46 confirmed.
- **0** positive cases today
- 28 tests were done today (25 Cadham, 3 Genexpert) 22 contacts were booked for today, the remaining of the Contact List. Contact Tracing is all up to date. 225 contacts were tested and 114 contacts are awaiting for test results from Cadham lab.
- Non Recovered
- 1 in ICU
- 18 households with active Covid 19 cases
- Average age of positive cases is 31 years old
- 40 confirmed positive cases are in AIA in Winnipeg. The Rapid Response Team Members will be scaled back starting tomorrow. 2-3 Team Members will be leaving tomorrow and 2 Members on Friday. Again this will be pending the outcome of the Cadham Test Results.

ISOLATION OFFICERS:

Two additional Isolation Officers were hired to date to make a compliment of 7 Isolation Officers and 1 driver. The Coordinator of this Program is Glindon Trout and can be reached at 431 230 2514 if you have any questions or concerns. They will be working from 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. for the remaining of the week.

The Isolation Site at Mikisew will be moved to the UCN Building within the week. Thank you CLEA and Councillor Wayne McLeod for accommodating and supporting this process.

All positive cases are isolating in AIA in Winnipeg, mandatory to go out.

All contacts of positive cases are to isolate for 14 days

All negative cases are to isolate for 14 days.

COVID 19 VACCINATION CLINICS

If you are an Elder 69 years and over and would like to take the Covid-19 Vaccine you can call 204-676-3426. Thank you to all the Elders that have taken the vaccine so far. We had 20 vaccinations scheduled for today.

It is not mandatory to take the COVID-19 vaccine but is strongly recommended that you take it to protect your home, your family and your community.

COMMUNITY LOCKDOWN:

The **COMMUNITY LOCKDOWN** has been lifted but the in community check stops will still be in place from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. to minimize traffic during the day for the remainder of the week and will be revisited on Friday.

SKI DOO PATROL:

The ski-doo patrol will still continue to monitor the ski-doo trails. No ski-doo's should be leaving the community.

SHOPPING DAYS SCHEDULE:

Remains the same

CLPPC SAFETY PLANS:

Just a reminder to the community if you are trying to organize something in the near future to ensure you fill out a Safety Plan. At present due to lockdown.

DISOBEYING COMMUNITY RESTRICTIONS:

We have a handful of people that are non compliant to our community restrictions and are still having house parties, doing things they should not be doing. You are putting people at risk.

If you have a notion of people breaking community restrictions, it is your responsibility to inform authorities. We have to do this to keep our community safe.
