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RED CRITICAL LEVEL CROSS LAKE MONDAY, NOVEMBER 16, 2020

CROSS LAKE IS STILL UNDER 24 HOUR LOCKDOWN. EVERYBODY IS FOLLOWING THE PROVINCIAL CRITICAL RED SYSTEM. THIS IS FOR THE WHOLE PROVINCE OF MANITOBA. NON ESSENTIAL TRAVEL WILL NOT BE PERMITTED.

THE PROVINCE OF MANITOBA HAD **392 POSITIVE CASES** TODAY November 16, 2020. **25 CASES** IN THE NORTHERN HEALTH REGION.

EPIDEMIOLOGICAL SUMMARY FOR COVID-19, CROSS LAKE, MANITOBA

BY THE PROVINCE OF MANITOBA

There are currently 71 confirmed cases in Cross Lake. **0** new cases have been reported since the last update on November 15, 2020.

81% of cases are considered recovered.

- As of 8:30 a.m. on November 16, PHIMS (Provincial Health Information Management System) had 71 cases entered with a Cross Lake residence. Note that residence might be out of date on PHIMS, and the Master List from front-line nurses is currently the source of truth for this report.
- 81% of all cases have recovered.
- Eight (8) additional cases will finish their 10-day Isolation period tomorrow.
- The cumulative incidence for Cross Lake is approximately 0.77% (733 per 100,000), slightly lower to the cumulative incidence in Manitoba overall (0.83%, 826 per 100,000).
- The 20-29 age group has been most significantly impacted by this outbreak, comprising 31% of all cases.
- 0 tests were conducted yesterday. **All existing contacts have been tested**, so testing is now focused on walk-in presenting with symptoms.
