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RED CRITICAL LEVEL CROSS LAKE WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 18, 2020

EVERYBODY HAS TO FOLLOW AND ABIDE BY THE PROVINCIAL RESPONSE LEVEL: **CRITICAL RED**. WHICH MEANS THAT COMMUNITY SPREAD OF COVID-19 IS NOT CONTAINED AND/OR THERE ARE SIGNIFICANT STRAINS ON OUR HEALTH CARE SYSTEM, THIS IS FOR THE WHOLE PROVINCE OF MANITOBA. PLEASE ABIDE BY THE CROSS LAKE HEALTH ORDER AND THE PROVINCIAL RESTRICTIONS AS PER PUBLIC HEALTH ORDERS. CROSS LAKE IS STILL UNDER 24 HOUR LOCKDOWN TILL FURTHER NOTICE.

THE PROVINCE OF MANITOBA HAD **399 POSITIVE CASES** TODAY November 18, 2020. **40 CASES** IN THE NORTHERN HEALTH REGION.

EPIDEMIOLOGICAL SUMMARY FOR COVID-19, CROSS LAKE, MANITOBA

94 % of all cases have recovered:

There are currently **73** confirmed cases **from** Cross Lake. **69** confirmed cases **in** Cross Lake, **4** are deemed off reserve. **1** new case have been reported since the last update as of yesterday. **This case was outside the community**. No tests were done today. There are additional tests still pending from Cadham Labs from swabs taken prior to November 16th. Some tests have leaked and may require re-testing if a GeneXpert test was not also performed. We will have more information tomorrow.

94% of all cases are considered recovered. Only two active cases remain and both are isolating in within Provincial AIA in Winnipeg.

- As of 8:30 a.m. on November 18, PHIMS (Provincial Health Information Management System) had **73** cases entered with a Cross Lake residence. Note that residence might be out of date on PHIMS, and the Master List from front-line nurses is currently the source of truth for this report. (People living off reserve that have not changed their address)
- 94 % of all cases have recovered.

- The 20-29 age group has been most significantly impacted by this outbreak, comprising 31% of all cases.
- **All existing contacts have been tested**, so testing is now focused on walk-in presenting with symptoms.

- **MEDICAL APPOINTMENTS WHO ARE DRIVING OUT TO APPOINTMENTS CANNOT TAKE OTHER PEOPLE WITH THEM IN THEIR VEHICLE. JUST THE PATIENT AND ESCORT.**
- **MEDICAL APPOINTMENTS WHO ARE GOING IN THE MEDICAL VANS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO BRING ANYTHING BACK BUT THEIR LUGGAGE.**

- IF YOU ARE ISOLATING AT MIKISEW SCHOOL, AND NEED ASSISTANCE. CALL RYAN CASTEL AT 204+676+0011.

RCMP UPDATE:

- BETWEEN NOVEMBER 2, 2020 AND NOVEMBER 13, 2020, THE RCMP RECEIVED 253 CALLS RELATED TO **COVID-19** IN THE PROVINCE
- IN 42 INSTANCES OFFICERS ISSUED A VERBAL WARNING, IN EIGHT INSTANCES, FINES WERE ISSUED FOR FAILING TO COMPLY WITH A PROVINCIAL EMERGENCY ORDER, UNDER THE PUBLIC HEALTH ACT.
- CROSS LAKE RCMP HAVE FINED PEOPLE FOR NOT COMPLYING TO THE PROVINCIAL EMERGENCY ORDER.

PLEASE ABIDE BY CROSS LAKE PUBLIC HEALTH ORDER.

INCARCERATIONS/HOMELESSNESS

- JUSTICE PROGRAM IS PRESENTLY WORKING ON THIS ISSUE OF OUR MEMBERS BEING RELEASED OR POTENTIALLY TO BE RELEASED FROM JAIL AND HOW WE CAN REPATRIATE THEM BACK INTO THE COMMUNITY.
- WILL HAVE TO SELF ISOLATE FOR 14 DAYS PRIOR TO RETURNING TO COMMUNITY.
- THIS IS PRESENTLY BEING WORKED ON BY STAFF.

SOCIAL SERVICES:

- THURSDAY AND FRIDAY WILL BE SOCIAL ASSISTANCE DISTRIBUTIONS FOR THE ONES THAT DID NOT HAVE A CHANCE TO PICK UP THEIR CHEQUES. THESE PEOPLE CAN DO THEIR SHOPPING ON THEIR DAY FROM THEIR RESPECTIVE AREA.

SHOPPING AREAS GUIDELINES:

- PLEASE FOLLOW THE SHOPPING BY AREA GUIDELINES. YOU WILL ONLY BE ALLOWED TO GO SHOP ON YOUR DAY AS IDENTIFIED BY YOUR AREA. PLEASE RESPECT THIS GUIDELINE.

POST OFFICE:

- THE POST OFFICE IS BEHIND ON THEIR MAIL DISTRIBUTION AND TRYING TO KEEP UP, PLEASE BE PATIENT.

KINDLY REMINDERS FROM THE CLPPC:

- **MANDATORY TO WEAR MASKS IN ALL PUBLIC PLACES TO CONTROL THE SPREAD OF COVID 19.**
- **PLEASE WASH OR SANITIZE YOUR HANDS AT ALL TIMES**
- **SOCIAL DISTANCING 6 FEET APART AT ALL TIMES.**
- **ABSOLUTELY NO VISITING OR ALLOWING VISITORS IN YOUR HOME. YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE TO PROTECT YOUR FAMILY. PEOPLE NEED TO STAY HOME. KOOSKWATAPIK**
- **PLEASE FOLLOW THE SHOPPING BY AREAS GUIDELINES. YOU WILL ONLY BE ALLOWED TO GO SHOP ON YOUR DAY AS IDENTIFIED BY YOUR AREA. PLEASE RESPECT THIS GUIDLEINE.**
- **THE POST OFFICE IS BACKLOGGED ON THEIR MAIL. PLEASE BE PATIENT.**
- **IF REQUIRED TO SELF ISOLATE, MEANING STAYING HOME IN ONE ROOM AT ALL TIMES**
- **24 HOUR CURFEW STILL IN EFFECT**

IN OUR MEETING TODAY WE WERE INFORMED THAT WE HAVE OUR OUTBREAK UNDER CONTROL, WE HAVE IT CONTAINED IN THE COMMUNITY. EVEN THOUGH THAT IS GOOD NEWS, WE STILL HAVE TO BE DILIGENT AND HAVE TO FOLLOW THE SAME SAFETY MEASURES AS PER CROSS LAKE HEALTH ORDER THAT WE PRESENTLY HAVE IN PLACE AND FURTHER FOLLOWING THE PROVINCIAL HEALTH ORDER. THESE ARE THE 24 HOUR LOCKDOWN, NO NON ESSENTIAL TRAVEL, 25% CAPACITY IN STORES NO GATHERINGS, JUST BECAUSE IT IS CONTAINED IN THE COMMUNITY, THE OUTBREAK IS STILL IN THE PROVINCE OF MANITOBA. THEY CANNOT CONTAIN IT AS IS, WHY THE PROVINCE IS IN CRITICAL RED.

THE FASTER WE FOLLOW THE RULES, THE FASTER WE CAN BE BACK TO NORMAL.

IF WE GO 14 CONSECUTIVE DAYS WITHOUT A NEW POSITIVE CASE THEN WE CAN START LIGHTENING UP ON THE RESTRICTIONS WITHIN CROSS LAKE. EACH AND EVERY ONE OF US ARE RESPONSIBLE TO ABIDE BY THE ORDERS IN PLACE AND KEEP OUR HOMES SAFE.
