## **RED CRITICAL LEVEL CROSS LAKE MONDAY, NOVEMBER 23, 2020**

THE PROVINCE OF MANITOBA HAD **543 POSITIVE CASES** TODAY November 23, 2020.  
**27 CASES** IN THE NORTHERN HEALTH REGION.

### **EPIDEMIOLOGICAL SUMMARY FOR COVID-19, CROSS LAKE, MANITOBA**

#### **97 % of all cases have recovered:**

There are currently **70** confirmed cases in Cross Lake. **0** new cases have been reported since the last update.

**97%** of all cases are considered recovered. Of the **2** active cases, are anticipated to be released from isolation by the end of the day. They do have to be symptom free for 24 hours after they finish their isolation. Both were isolating outside of the community.

**4** tests were conducted over the weekend – 1 was negative and 3 are pending.

There are **5** contacts actively isolating. The last contact will be released from Isolation by November 27.

**WE HAVE RECENTLY LOST A BROTHER AND FRIEND THE LATE DOUGLAS ROSS TO COMPLICATIONS OF COVID RELATED HEALTH ISSUES. HE WAS WELL LOVED BY THE COMMUNITY AND PARTICIPATED IN MANY COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES. HE WAS A MAN OF FAITH AND WILL BE SADLY MISSED BY ALL THAT KNEW HIM. HE DID NOT LIVE IN THE COMMUNITY FOR SOME TIME BUT WILL BE MAKING HIS LAST JOURNEY HOME TO PIMICIKAMAK FOR A ONE NIGHT WAKE AND THEN TO HIS FINAL RESTING PLACE.**

**HE WILL BE TRANSPORTED FROM WINNIPEG TO THOMPSON TOMORROW AND THEN TO CROSS LAKE ON WEDNESDAY. FURTHER ANNOUNCEMENTS WILL BE MADE AS THINGS PROGRESS.**
