THE PROVINCE OF MANITOBA HAD **344 POSITIVE CASES** TODAY November 27, 2020.
73 CASES IN THE NORTHERN HEALTH REGION.

EPIDEMIOLOGICAL SUMMARY FOR COVID-19, CROSS LAKE, MANITOBA

99 % of all cases have recovered:

There are currently **79** confirmed cases in Cross Lake. **9** new cases have been reported since Tuesday's update. **5** are in Thompson, **4** are associated with Dialysis unit plus **1** Escort. Most of these cases are out of town that have Cross Lake addresses. **2** cases arrived before they knew they were positive (they are in Isolation).

- **2** in Provincial AIA
- **1** in community and will be sent out today.
- There are **16** active contacts identified
- **2** in Thompson, **1** in Winnipeg
