MONDAY, APRIL 19, 2021

As of today, April 19, 2021, 108 new cases of the virus have been identified in Manitoba. 5 new cases in the Northern Health Region; 63 cases in Winnipeg. Public health officials advise the first case of the P1 variant of concern, first identified in Brazil, has been confirmed in Manitoba. The case was identified in an individual from the Interlake-Eastern health region on Friday.

There are now 6 cases of the UK Variant B.1.1.7 in the Northern Health Region. If you have travelled to Thompson, The Pas or Winnipeg, you need to self-monitor for 14 days.
