RED CRITICAL LEVEL FOR CROSS LAKE

THURSDAY, APRIL 22, 2021

As of today, April 21, 2021, 258 new cases of the virus have been identified in Manitoba. 36 new cases in the Northern Health Region; 159 cases in Winnipeg. There are 23 cases of the Variant B.1.1.7 and 2 unspecified Variants in the Northern Health Region.

Public health officials advise of a possible exposure to the B.1.1.7 variant of concern at McDonalds, 217 Mystery Lake Rd. in Thompson on April 8 from 4 p.m. to 12:00 a.m.; April 10 and 11 from 6 a.m. to 2 p.m.; and April 13 and 14 from 2 to 10 p.m. Any person experiencing symptoms since attending the site should isolate immediately and go for testing.
