TUESDAY, APRIL 27, 2021

As of today, April 27, 2021, 217 new cases of the virus have been identified in Manitoba. 12 new cases in the Northern Health Region; 156 cases in Winnipeg. There are 42 cases of the Variant B.1.1.7 and 4 unspecified Variants in the Northern Health Region.

Results for April 27, 2021 the COVID-19 SUMMARY FOR CROSS LAKE IS AS FOLLOWS:
