As of today, April 8, 2021, 137 new cases of the virus have been identified in Manitoba. 55 new cases in the Northern Health Region; 60 cases in Winnipeg.

The total number of confirmed variant of concern cases of B.1.1.7 (U.K.) is 298, the total number of variant of concern cases of B.1.351 (South African) is 20, and the total number of variant of concern cases that have not been categorized is 21, bringing the total number of confirmed variant of concern cases to 339.
