RED CRITICAL LEVEL FOR CROSS LAKE

SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 21, 2021

As of today, February 21, 2021, **58** new cases of the virus have been identified in Manitoba.
25 new cases in the Northern Health Region

The COVID 19 virus is Community Spread in Cross Lake. This means that it is no longer contained to families or gatherings and people are getting tested from all over the community and are testing positive. Many of these contacts are becoming symptomatic, meaning they are getting sick from COVID-19.

As of today February 21, 2021 the COVID-19 SUMMARY FOR CROSS LAKE IS AS FOLLOWS:

- **258 total** positive cases in Cross Lake on Reserve from February 8, 2021
- **16 new** Positive Cases today (4 Results from Cadham Lab)
- **11 new** Positive Cases yesterday
- **176 Active Positive Cases (87 of these are children)**
 - **121 Positive cases** in AIA - Alternate Isolation Accommodations (1 in Hospital)
 - **86 cases pending AIA** (Includes some close contacts)
 - **82 cases Recovered**
- **174 households** affected
- **6 in ICU**
- **29.4%** of cases have a chronic condition
- Approximately **6.4%** of Cross Lake Community Members have been diagnosed with Covid-19 virus.

The Rapid Response Team has completed 753 swabs since **February 12th, 2021**. Of those, 588 have been put through Point of Care (rapid) testing, with 169 positive results, making the positivity rate for swabs completed by the RRT 28.7%. Please note, these numbers do not contain additional positive results from CADHAM testing.
