As of today, March 14, 2021, 44 new cases of the virus have been identified in Manitoba. 14 new cases in the Northern Health Region; 23 cases in Winnipeg.

Public Health makes appointments for the COVID Tests (204)676-5663. The RRT will be testing people **all weekend**. Contacts are still being tested, please if you have been called to get tested, do so.

As of today March 14, 2021 the COVID-19 SUMMARY FOR CROSS LAKE IS AS FOLLOWS:

- **409 total** positive cases in Cross Lake on Reserve from February 8, 2021
- **6 new** Positive Cases (6 Rapid + 0 Cadham)
- **39 Active Positive Cases**
 - **28 Positive cases** in AIA - Alternate Isolation Accommodations
 - **11 Active Cases** in Cross Lake
 - **82 Contacts** isolating in Cross Lake
 - **5 positive cases** pending AIA Winnipeg
 - **3 Contacts** pending AIA Winnipeg
 - **6 positive cases** left on Charter
 - **367 cases Recovered**
- **200+** households affected
- **2 in ICU**
- **1 Death (3 total)**
- Testing tomorrow March 15: will be testing 5 Contacts
