As of today, March 19, 2021, 93 new cases of the virus have been identified in Manitoba. 29 new cases in the Northern Health Region; 39 cases in Winnipeg.

No new cases of variants of concern have been identified as of today. However, further reviews have reclassified one case previously identified as B.1.1.7 variant of concern case as a B.1.351 variant of concern. The total number of confirmed variant of concern cases is 76.

Public Health makes appointments for the COVID Tests (204)676-5663. Contacts are still being tested, please if you have been called to get tested, do so.

As of today March 19, 2021 the COVID-19 SUMMARY FOR CROSS LAKE IS AS FOLLOWS:

- **426 total** positive cases in Cross Lake on Reserve from February 8, 2021
- **1 new** Positive Case (0 Rapid + 1 Cadham)
- **29 Active Positive Cases**
 - **28 Positive cases** in AIA - Alternate Isolation Accommodations
 - **1 Active Case** in Cross Lake
 - **70 Contacts** isolating in Cross Lake
 - **1 positive case** pending AIA Winnipeg
 - **5 Contacts** pending AIA Winnipeg
 - **2 positive cases** left on Charter
 - **391 cases Recovered**
- **200+** households affected
- **2 in ICU**
- **0 Deaths (4 total)**
- Testing tomorrow March 20: will be testing 7 Contacts
