As of today, March 22, 2021, 65 new cases of the virus have been identified in Manitoba. 17 new cases in the Northern Health Region; 45 cases in Winnipeg.

Public health officials are announcing one confirmed case to be a result of the B.1.1.7 COVID-19 variant of concern has been detected. This case is from the Prairie Mountain Health region.

Public Health makes appointments for the COVID Tests (204)676-5663. Contacts are still being tested, please if you have been called to get tested, do so.

As of today March 22, 2021 the COVID-19 SUMMARY FOR CROSS LAKE IS AS FOLLOWS:

- **434 total** positive cases in Cross Lake on Reserve from February 8, 2021
- **2 new** Positive Cases (0 Rapid + 2 Cadham)
- **34 Active Positive Cases**
 - **31 Positive cases** in AIA - Alternate Isolation Accommodations
 - **1 Active Case** in Cross Lake
 - **59 Contacts** isolating in Cross Lake
 - **1 positive case** pending AIA Winnipeg
 - **1 Contact** pending AIA Winnipeg
 - **4 positive cases** left on Charter
 - **398 cases Recovered**
- **200+** households affected
- **2 in ICU**
- **0 Deaths (4 total)**
- Testing tomorrow March 23: will be testing 23 Contacts
