As of today, March 23, 2021, 93 new cases of the virus have been identified in Manitoba. 31 new cases in the Northern Health Region; 57 cases in Winnipeg.

The total number of confirmed variant of concern cases of B.1.1.7 is 63 and B.1.351 is 14, bringing the total number of confirmed variant of concern cases to 77.

Cross Lake Public Health makes appointments for the COVID Tests (204)676-5663. Contacts are still being tested, please if you have been called to get tested, do so.

As of today March 23, 2021 the COVID-19 SUMMARY FOR CROSS LAKE IS AS FOLLOWS:

- **1 new** Positive Case (1 Rapid + 0 Cadham)
- **29 Active Positive Cases**

 - **43 Contacts** isolating in Cross Lake
 - **2 positive cases** pending AIA Winnipeg
 - **6 Contacts** pending AIA Winnipeg
 - **2 positive cases** left on Charter
 - **401 cases Recovered**
- **200+** households affected
- **2 in ICU plus 1 Hospital**
- **0 Deaths (4 total)**
- Testing tomorrow March 24: will be testing 0 Contacts
