As of today, March 27, 2021, 57 new cases of the virus have been identified in Manitoba. 23 new cases in the Northern Health Region; 26 cases in Winnipeg.

The total number of confirmed variant of concern cases of B.1.1.7 is 109 and B.1.351 is 14, bringing the total number of confirmed variant of concern cases to 123.

Cross Lake Public Health makes appointments for the COVID Tests (204)676-5663. Contacts are still being tested, please if you have been called to get tested, do so.

As of today March 27, 2021 the COVID-19 SUMMARY FOR CROSS LAKE IS AS FOLLOWS:
