RED CRITICAL LEVEL FOR CROSS LAKE

TUESDAY, MARCH 2, 2021

As of today, March 2, 2021, **64** new cases of the virus have been identified in Manitoba. **16** new cases in the Northern Health Region.

Contacts are still being tested, please if you have been called to get tested, do so.

Public Health makes appointments for the COVID Tests (204)676-5663. The RRT changed over and were testing people over the weekend. Appointments can be made through Public Health at the Nursing Station if you are symptomatic and want to be tested.

As of today March 2, 2021 the COVID-19 SUMMARY FOR CROSS LAKE IS AS FOLLOWS:

- **320 total** positive cases in Cross Lake on Reserve from February 8, 2021
- **0 new** Positive Cases (0 Rapid + 0 Cadham)
- **81 Active Positive Cases**
 - **48 Positive cases** in AIA - Alternate Isolation Accommodations
 - **18 cases pending** AIA (Positive plus some close contacts)
 - **153 Contacts** isolating in Cross Lake
 - **21 left to AIA on charters**
 - **255 cases Recovered**
- **200+** households affected
- **2 in ICU plus 3 in Hospital**
- Testing tomorrow March 3: will be testing 36 contacts

CANADIAN ARMED FORCES:

- 26 from Canadian Armed Forces are in the community (14 days, assessment on day 7, day 14). We've requested they stay until March 9, 2021.
- They are here to assist in the monitoring of our Isolators & Elders that were vaccinated - to check their vitals etc. and to help out where they can.

AMC AMBASSADORS

- 30 AMC Ambassadors are in Cross Lake assisting on the Check Stops and Security. They will also assist in the delivery of cleaning supplies, hampers, etc.

VACCINATIONS:

Within the next couple of weeks, Vaccines will be available for Cross Lake Residents in the community. Chief and Council with the support of the Mayor and Council, CLPPC worked hard pursuing that the vaccines be brought to the community of Cross Lake. We'll let you know when it's going to happen.

We need the pre-registration forms to be filled out at the latest March 12, 2021.

BORDER CHECK STOP

As of Midnight , Wednesday, March 3, 2021 - the Check Stop at the Border will be closed from Midnight until 6 a.m. except for Essential Services.
