As of today, March 31, 2021, 70 new cases of the virus have been identified in Manitoba. 24 new cases in the Northern Health Region; 38 cases in Winnipeg.

The total number of confirmed variant of concern cases of B.1.1.7 is 232, the total number of variant of concern cases of B.1.351 is 20, and the total number of variant of concern cases that have not been categorized is 15, bringing the total number of confirmed variant of concern cases to 267.

As of today March 31, 2021 the COVID-19 SUMMARY FOR CROSS LAKE IS AS FOLLOWS:

 - **430 cases Recovered**
- **200+** households affected
- **3 in Hospital**
- **0 Deaths (5 total)**
- Testing tomorrow April 1: will be testing 0 Contacts
