**SUNDAY, MARCH 7, 2021**

THERE ARE CHANGES TO THE PUBLIC HEALTH ORDERS THAT CAME INTO EFFECT MARCH 5, 2021 AS PER ANNOUNCEMENT BY THE PREMIER OF MANITOBA AND DR. BRENT ROUSSIN. WE STILL HAVE CONTACTS THAT ARE BEING TESTED AND WILL CONTINUE THROUGHOUT THE WEEKEND AND NEXT WEEK. WE CAN ONLY KEEP RELAYING THE SAME MESSAGE REGARDING THE SPREAD OF COVID IN THE COMMUNITY. **PEOPLE THAT ARE CONTACTS NEED TO STAY AT HOME, STICK TO YOUR OWN BUBBLE WHICH MEANS YOUR FAMILY THAT LIVES WITH YOU**

***As of today, March 7, 2021, 56 new cases of the virus have been identified in Manitoba. 27 new cases in the Northern Health Region. 24 cases in Winnipeg.***

**Public Health makes appointments for the COVID Tests (204)676-5663. The RRT will be testing people all week. Appointments can be made through Public Health at the Nursing Station, if you are symptomatic and want to be tested. Contacts are still being tested, please if you have been called to get tested, do so.**

### **As of today March 7, 2021 the COVID-19 SUMMARY FOR CROSS LAKE IS AS FOLLOWS:**

- **379 total** positive cases in Cross Lake on Reserve from February 8, 2021
- **6 new** Positive Cases (1 Rapid + 5 Cadham)
- **78 Active Positive Cases**
  - **57 Positive cases** in AIA - Alternate Isolation Accommodations
  - **22 Active Cases** in Cross Lake
  - **169 Contacts** isolating in Cross Lake
  - **21 positive cases** pending AIA Winnipeg
  - **5 Contacts** pending AIA Winnipeg
  - **4 positive cases** left on Charters
  - **298 cases Recovered**
- **200+** households affected
- **2 in ICU**
- Testing tomorrow March 8: will be testing 18 Contacts
