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RED CRITICAL LEVEL FOR CROSS LAKE

SATURDAY , NOVEMBER 14, 2020

EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 12, 2020 AT 12:01 A.M. THE PROVINCIAL RESPONSE LEVEL WENT TO CRITICAL RED. THIS ORDER WILL BE IN EFFECT UNTIL 11:59 P.M. DECEMBER 11, 2020.

MEANING THAT COMMUNITY SPREAD OF COVID-19 IS NOT CONTAINED AND/OR THERE ARE SIGNIFICANT STRAINS ON OUR HEALTH CARE SYSTEM. THE NEW CRITICAL (RED) LEVEL RESTRICTIONS WILL BE IN EFFECT PROVINCE WIDE.

THE PROVINCE OF MANITOBA HAD **239 POSITIVE CASES** TODAY November 12, 2020. **16 CASES** IN THE NORTHERN HEALTH REGION.

68 CONFIRMED CASES (1 – OFF RESERVE)

51 RECOVERED CASES

- 0 POSITIVE CASES FOR TODAY
- 3 PRESENTLY HOSPITALIZED (PAST THEIR INFECTIOUS DATES BUT HAVE NOT BEEN CONFIRMED SYMPTOM FREE FOR 24 HOURS). ONE PATIENT HAS BEEN TRANSFERRED TO THOMPSON GENERAL HOSPITAL

TESTING:

- 2 NURSES FROM THE RAPID RESPONSE TEAM ARE STILL TESTING IN THE COMMUNITY AND ARE NOW SITUATED IN THE BLUE DOME TENT BY THE NURSING STATION. PLEASE PHONE NURSING STATION TO MAKE APPOINTMENTS.

- **ISOLATION:**

POSITIVE CASES THAT WERE BEING MOVED OUT OF CROSS LAKE TO ALTERNATIVE ISOLATION ACCOMODATIONS – CLOSER TO HOSPITALS IF THEY BECOME SYMPTOMATIC.

- **14 INDIVIDUALS ISOLATING IN WINNIPEG AIA**
- **11 INDIVIDUALS ISOLATING IN WINNIPEG RED CROSS**
- **04 INDIVIDUALS ISOLATING IN CROSS LAKE**
- **38 PREVIOUSLY IDENTIFIED CONTACTS CURRENTLY BEING ACTIVELY MONITORED ON A DAILY BASIS BY PUBLIC HEALTH REGION, HEALTH CANADA**

- **SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 14, 2020, 19 INDIVIDUALS WILL BE COMING HOME FROM ISOLATION IN WINNIPEG.**

NURSING STATION IS WORKING WITH PUBLIC HEALTH ON REPATRIATION ARRANGEMENTS (HOW TO BRING THEM HOME)

PEOPLE STAYING IN THE ALTERNATIVE ISOLATION ACCOMMODATIONS IS PROCESSED THROUGH HEALTH CANADA AND NOT THE CROSS LAKE BAND OF INDIANS. A LIMITED NUMBER OF HOTELS ARE UTILIZED FOR THIS PROCESS. IN CROSS LAKE, MIKISEW SCHOOL WAS IDENTIFIED AS A ISOLATION FACILITY.

MEDICAL PATIENTS MUST HAVE A SAFE HOME TO RETURN TO, MEANING NO ONE SELF ISOLATING OR SELF MONITORING IN THE HOME. IF HOME IS NOT CLEARED, THEIR STAY WILL BE EXTENDED TILL THE HOME IS CLEARED BY PUBLIC HEALTH. FOR CLEARANCE, THE MEDICAL PATIENT WILL HAVE TO CALL LISA NAUCHBAR OR NIC RANDALL AT NURSING STATION. 204-676-2011.

SHOPPING DISTRICTS MUST BE FOLLOWED AND WILL BE MONITORED. PLEASE ABIDE BY THE AREA DISIGNATED FOR YOU.

THE FASTER WE FOLLOW THE RULES, THE FASTER WE CAN BE BACK TO NORMAL. DO NOT GO TO STORES IF YOU'RE SUPPOSED TO BE ISOLATING THAT PUTS EVERYONE AT RISK. LIFE IS VERY PRECIOUS.
