**THURSDAY NOVEMBER 6, 2020**

- **STAY HOME! PLEASE LISTEN**
- **OUR TASK IS TO GET RID OF THIS VIRUS – GET BACK TO 0 IN CROSS LAKE**
- **NEW RESTRICTIONS – TO SHUT DOWN THE TRAFFIC & REDUCE PEOPLE IN STORES**
  - **DESIGNATED SHOPPING AREAS – SEE “SHOPPING AREAS DURING LOCKDOWN”**
  - **BEGINNING MONDAY, NOVEMBER 9, 2020 TO ENSURE SAFETY**
  - **WON'T BE ABLE TO GO TO STORE EVERYDAY**
  - **WHEN IT'S YOUR SHOPPING DAY, CHECK MAIL, GET YOUR MEDICINES FROM PHARMACY**
  - **SHOPPING, ONE PERSON IN VEHICLE**
  - **NO CHILDREN IN STORES**
- **SAFETY OFFICERS & RCMP WILL BE MONITORING TRAFFIC (VEHICLES & WALKERS). YOU WILL BE SENT HOME**
- **GAS STATIONS ARE CLOSED AT 5:00 p.m.**
- **YOU MUST STAY HOME IF YOU'RE TOLD TO ISOLATE- THE DATE GIVEN BY PUBLIC HEALTH**
- **DON'T GO OUT VISITING, YOU CAN SPREAD THE VIRUS**
  - **UNDER THE QUARANTINE ACT, YOU CAN BE CHARGED**
- **IT'S EVERYONE'S RESPONSIBILITY TO KEEP CROSS LAKE SAFE**
- **REMINDE YOUR CHILDREN NOT TO PLAY NEXT DOOR**
- **REMEMBRANCE DAY – NO EVENTS – OFFER A PRAYER AT CENOTATH WHEN NO ONE THERE**

THE PROVINCE OF MANITOBA HAD 243 POSITIVE CASES TODAY. 23 IN THE NORTH

**CROSS LAKE DAILY RESULTS: NOVEMBER 6, 2020**

- **7 POSITIVE CASE TODAY (38 TESTS DONE: 22 RAPID, 16 CADHAM)**
  - **60 CASES AS OF YESTERDAY**
  - **67 ACTIVE POSITIVE CASES FOR CROSS LAKE IN TOTAL**
- **THE RAPID RESPONSE TEAM ARE STILL TESTING**
- **3 PRESENTLY IN HOSPITAL; 1 IN BRANDON, 1 IN WINNIPEG & 1 IN THOMPSON**
- **POSITIVE CASES BEING MOVED OUT OF CROSS LAKE TO ALTERNATIVE ISOLATION ACCOMODATIONS – CLOSER TO HOSPITALS.**

WE PRESENTLY HAVE THE RAPID RESPONSE TEAM IN OUR COMMUNITY OF CROSS LAKE WHO ARE TESTING CONTACTS FROM WITHIN THE COMMUNITY. WE MAY HAVE **COMMUNITY SPREAD** NOW, NOT JUST CLUSTERS. IF YOU FEEL ANY SYMPTOMS OR WERE IN CONTACT WITH A PERSON THAT IS COVID-POSITIVE, PLEASE CALL THE NURSING STATION AT 676-2011 FOR A PUBLIC HEALTH APPOINTMENT.

IT IS IMPORTANT THAT IF YOU ARE FEELING ILL, FEELING SICK THAT YOU CALL THE NURSING STATION. KAWINA KATA KITAKOSIWIN (DO NOT HIDE YOUR SICKNESS)

**THE FASTER WE FOLLOW THE RULES, THE FASTER WE CAN BE BACK TO NORMAL.** DO NOT GO TO STORES IF YOU'RE SUPPOSED TO BE ISOLATING THAT PUTS EVERYONE AT RISK.
