## CROSS LAKE RESTORING SAFE SERVICE

### PHASE THREE EFFECTIVE JUNE 30, 2020

- The Cross Lake Check Stop will continue to remain until further notice.
- No Authorization Forms will be required to go through Check Stop for local community members. At any point if positive cases are confirmed North of 53 Parallel, the CLPPC will immediately convert back to previous restrictions.
- Questionnaire Forms will continue to be required to fill out at Check Stop when entering the community. Temperatures will continue to be taken and recorded. (This is important for Contact Tracing in the event of positive COVID – 19 cases in the community).
- Community Members will follow Out of Province Guidelines. (Western Provinces and Northwestern Ontario)
- Curfew will still be in effect (10 p.m. to 6 a.m) 17 and under
- All Restaurants may open with seating arrangements two meters apart.
- Pimicikamak Gaming Center and Cross Lake Inn will operate as per COVID-19 Safety Plan and will adhere to public health guidelines.
- Indoor Public Gatherings will be 50 people and 100 people outdoors and will adhere to social distancing guidelines, except for brief exchanges. This change also applies to social gatherings, churches, weddings, funerals as well as powwow's and other Indigenous cultural and spiritual events. These Gatherings must follow public health guidelines for the venue they are being held.
- Specific Guidelines have been developed in collaboration with AMC and MKO to ensure physical distancing is followed for drum groups, dancers, and singers that are integral to these gatherings.
- All Organized Events will have to fill out an COVID – 19 Safety Plan Application. How the organizer will follow Public Health Guidelines.
- All Food Venues will have to fill out an COVID – 19 Safety Plan Application. How the owner will follow Public Health Guidelines. (will be provided)
- Softball Manitoba COVID – 19 Guidelines will be utilized till further notice. (Guidelines will be provided)
- All Sports will follow the Sport Manitoba Guidelines (ie: volleyball, paddling, basketball, fastball, soccer, etc.)
