COMMUNITY NOTICE

AUGUST 22, 2020

Our Community has learned that there is a confirmed COVID-19 positive case in Gillam, Manitoba. The person travelled by vehicle from the Prairie Mountain Region (Brandon, Dauphin area) and was in Gillam August 12 – 21, 2020. The person was notified through Contact Tracing that the person was in close contact to a confirmed Covid 19 positive case in the Prairie Mountain Health Region. The person immediately started to self isolate and later on developed symptoms and a positive test was confirmed on Friday. The person returned home to the PMHR on August 21, 2020.

At this time the Chief and Council, Mayor and Council and the Cross Lake Pandemic Planning Committee are restricting access for anyone travelling from Gillam, Manitoba or who was in Gillam during the period of August 12 – 21, 2020. All person's who have been in Gillam during the above noted period must be tested immediately and self monitor for symptoms.

This is the purpose why the Chief and Council, Mayor and Council and the Cross Lake Pandemic Planning Committee had limited access to Cross Lake to our citizens and Norway House Residents.

As you can see our local recreational events have also limited participation to Pimicikamak Citizens and family and to Norway House only.

We currently are hosting Adwen Memorial Baseball Tournament occurring with approximately 18 teams from Cross Lake and Norway House only.

This is a good reminder that the COVID -19 virus has not gone away and we will need to continue to be vigilant on how we conduct ourselves, our families and our Community.

The Cross Lake Pandemic Planning Committee will continue to monitor the cases through information provided by the Province of Manitoba.

Again, social distancing with outside community members are advised, washing of hands or sanitizing of hands, wearing of masks are recommended at all times.
