## **TRAVEL GUIDELINES TO AND FROM CROSS LAKE FOR CROSS LAKE BAND OF INDIANS OFF-RESERVE MEMBERS/CROSS LAKE COMMUNITY MEMBERS**

As of June 1, 2020, Cross Lake Band of Indians Off-Reserve Members and Community Members will have **ACCESS** to and from the Cross Lake Community on a case by case basis.

Off Reserve Members and Community Members entering the community will be under **specific guidelines** during visits.

For Off Reserve Member and Community Member **ACCESS**, you must abide by the following:

- First request for Access by calling the Cross Lake Band of Indians office at 1 – 204 -676 -2218 and you will have to answer the Cross Lake State of Emergency Check Stop Questionnaire. Once the Questionnaire is complete and results are acceptable to the Access Guidelines then you will be permitted to request for an Authorization Form.
- You will be provided with an Authorization Form through fax or email. The onus will on you or your family to ensure that the Authorization Form is filled out and signed prior to your entry into the Community.
- You must declare the residence you are visiting and how long you will be staying in the community. Members are restricted to visiting/staying in one residence and not travelling and visiting around in the community.
- You will be screened when entering the Check Stop, your temperature will be taken, your vehicle will be searched for contraband and/or alcohol. If you are caught with any contraband and/or alcohol you will be denied entry.

- No visiting with other families or households in the community is allowed until 14 consecutive days in the community.
- No stopping or shopping at stores including fuel and groceries.
- Adhere to Community Curfew (10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.)<sup>17</sup> and under
- Visitors coming into Cross Lake Community must have not travelled outside of Manitoba.
- Any Members not following guidelines will be escorted out of the community and possibly have future access privileges denied.
- Anyone found experiencing symptoms will be asked to take a COVID-19 test (24-48 hours) and placed under isolation at 24/7 till results come back. If results are negative, the patient will be allowed to leave 24/7. If the result is positive the patient will continue isolation at 24/7 as per Public Health Measures and Plan.
- In the case of a positive COVID-19 in the community or an increase in cases North of the 53<sup>rd</sup> Parallel, as determined by the Northern Regional Health Authority (NRHA) Off-Reserve membership access will be denied immediately, **absolutely no access to the community of Cross Lake.**

For Off-Reserve Members and Community Members will have to follow above noted procedures while in the Community.

For Off-Reserve Members and Community Members residing outside Manitoba, ACCESS will not be permitted at this time. Will be reviewed when the Province lifts the Interprovincial Travel Restrictions. Out of Province Travel will not be permitted.

- ❖ **For On-Reserve Members and Community Members leaving the Community, you will be required to fill out the above noted documents and abide by this Travel Guideline upon return. Your name will be added to the Self Monitor List and will be required to self monitor for 14 days.**

Everyone must continue to practice social distancing 6 feet apart, kacicice and stay safe!
